<p>Students continue their study of the GCSE course. They study Muslim practices. When they have the beliefs and teachings of two religions completed they move on to study the four themes of understanding Relationships and Families; Religion and Life; Religion, Peace and Conflict; and Religion, Crime and Punishment.</p>
