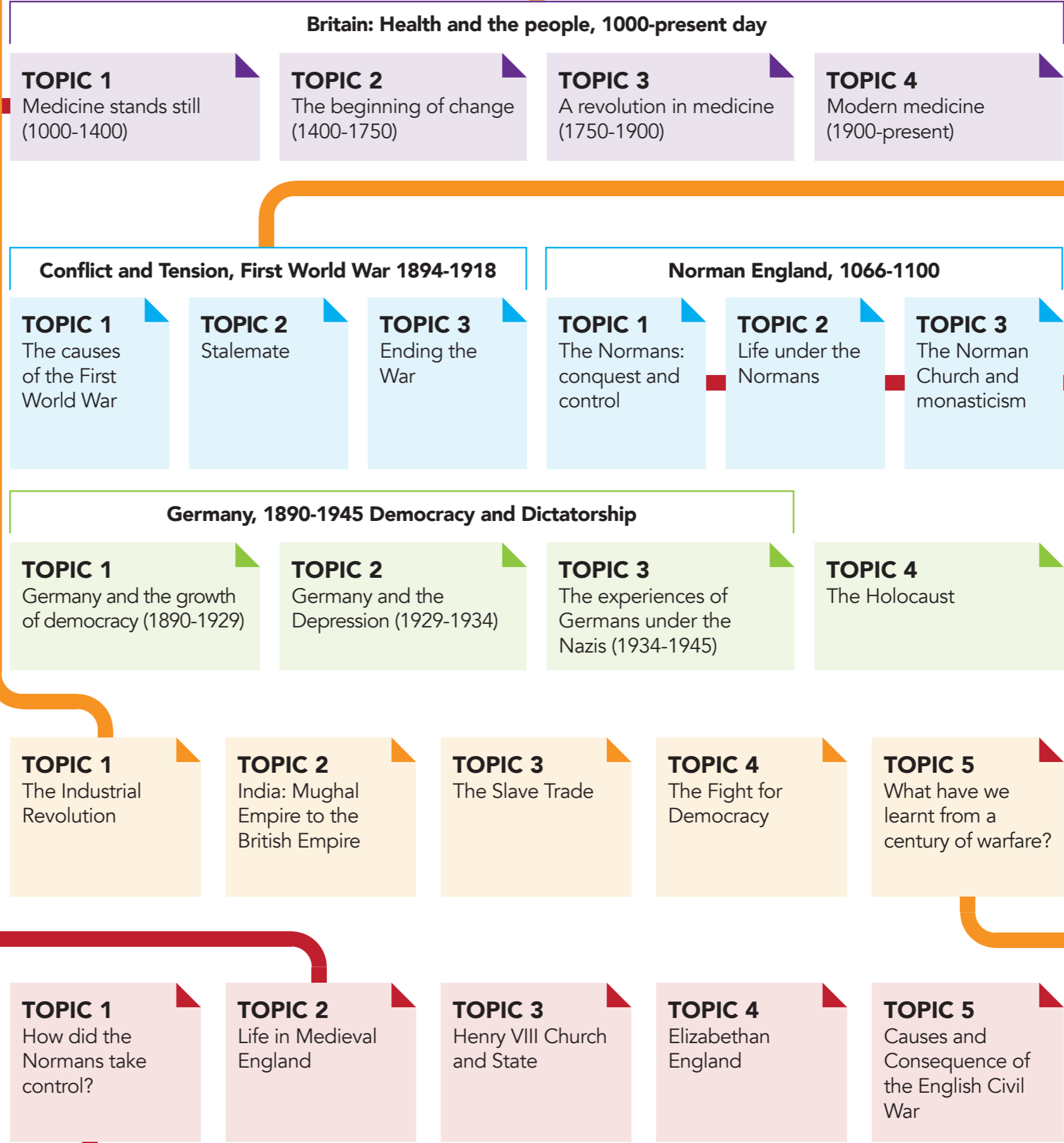

Topic 1 of the GCSE Germany, interweaves with Topic 3 of the GCSE First World War. In particular the abdication of Kaiser Wilhelm II.

Year 8 Industrial Revolution, links with Health and the People. Topics such as the growth of Industrial towns and public health.

Year 8 What have we learnt from a century of warfare, links to GCSE First World War and Health and the People. Topics include surgery during the war and the impact of World War 1.

Year 7, Life in Medieval England, links with GCSE Normans and Health and the People. Topics such as medieval towns, villages and religion during the medieval period.

Year 7, How did the Normans take control, links with GCSE Normans. Topics such as the contenders to the throne in 1066, the battles, castles, Domesday book, Harrying of the North and the Feudal System.

Year 10 Normans will feature a specific historic environment, which students will be assessed on. This changes each year.
