## Assessment Model

Students have ongoing assessment from their teachers in lessons, teachers will use a range of methods to do this, from observation, questioning, talking to students and providing feedback in their exercise books/folders.

Formal assessments take place in the form of milestones, which are usually an end of unit test (some can be practical in practical subjects). This falls within a window of time, to allow teachers to assess how students' progress and provide feedback. The dates for milestone assessments follow the dates below. To allow flexibility for teachers and to avoid students having a whole week of milestone tests they are planned within the time window by different curriculum teams.

Milestones are used with other assessment information to inform the termly attainment grade reported to parents and carers.
